Low Income Cat Sterilizations Program 2022

The Low Income Sterilization Program offers low cost spay/neuter of cats for qualifying residents of the City of Prince Albert. This procedure is done at participating veterinary clinics. The program is offered through revenue generated from the sale of cat licenses. The goal of the Program is to increase the number of sterilized pets and reduce the number of unwanted and homeless cats in the city of Prince Albert.

Why Spay and Neuter?

There is a serious pet overpopulation crisis within our community. Not only does it reduce the number of unwanted, abandoned and stray animals within our community, but it has other benefits such as:

- Improved health and a longer life of the animal
- No unwanted or accidental litters
- Less aggressiveness, less desire to ream and reduction of felines spraying

To be eligible for the program, the participant must:

- Be 18 years of age or older;
- Be a residents of the City of Prince Albert;
- Be the owner and keeper of the pet being sterilized;
- Provide proof of income

Qualifying Low Income Amounts:

- Single without children- \$18,292
- Single with children- \$28,209
- Family without children- \$28,209
- Family with children- \$28,209

How to Apply:

Complete, sign and date the application, and return by email, fac, or regular mail. **Be sure to include a copy of your proof of residency** (ie: Driver's License) **and proof of income**.
